More schools are adopting technologies to understand what students are doing on school devices and to receive proactive alerts when concerning behaviours arise. However, many systems generate unnecessary noise, leading to false positives and alert fatigue.

For example, is a student researching a school project or just playing a game? Is it a real issue or part of normal learning?

The challenge for schools is getting the right balance between the amount of alerts and reports and the trust and confidence they have in them. Trust in the system is key to making confident decisions and ensuring nothing important gets missed.

Welcome to Linewize Monitor

Linewize Monitor is a real-time digital alerting and reporting solution for wellbeing teams.

It helps staff identify and address issues like bullying, offensive language, and other concerning behaviours that could be happening right in front of you during the school day. And, when needed, visibility can be extended beyond school hours for specific groups, like boarders or students of concern.

Unlike traditional systems with binary alerts, which often generate false positives, Monitor uses a 1-5 scale to assess severity, context, and other factors. It also tracks the frequency of behaviours to gauge their seriousness. To provide more context, the platform captures screenshots to help staff make informed decisions.

With a trained human moderation team, Monitor ensures accurate categorisation of alerts **before** they reach the school, giving staff confidence in the system.





How it works

Linewize Monitor is a semi-managed service that combines AI with trained human moderators to identify and alert on negative online behaviours. This powerful combination reduces false positives and enhances the school's ability to respond effectively.

Monitor uses advanced behavioural technology to analyse everything a student types across Google, Office 365, offline documents, web chats, social media, and more.

Low-level alerts are logged in the dashboard with context and screen captures for staff to review when they next log in.

Medium to highest level alerts are escalated to a highly trained human moderation team for review, eliminating any remaining false positives.

Alerts are sent to the school via email or phone, depending on severity.

Schools can also increase oversight for specific groups, such as boarders or vulnerable students, by creating bespoke schedules that fit their needs.

Alerts are created in real-time and rated 1–5 based on behaviour frequency and severity, so designated staff can focus on what matters most.

✓ Grading system

Low-level risks are logged in the Monitor portal for staff to review the next time they log in. Higher-level risks are communicated to the school's designated staff immediately by email. Highest level alerts, including suspected risks to health or life, are communicated by phone.

Human oversight

Al flags behaviour, but only humans can interpret tone, context, and patterns over time. That's why trained moderators review each high-level alert, ensuring only real concerns reach your team—backed by evidence to guide next steps, from student support to parent engagement or wider wellbeing actions.


√ Full-screen risk assessment

✓ Alerting profiles

Everyone in a school cares about student wellbeing—but not everyone has the same responsibility or needs the same level of visibility. With Monitor, you can easily set up tailored alerting profiles that define who receives which alerts, and how often. For example, a Level 3 bullying alert might be sent to the Head of Year, but a Level 5 is sent to the Director of Wellbeing and the Head of Senior School.

The bigger the problem, the broader the visibility.

Flags behaviours across seven critical categories, including mental health, bullying, violence, self-harm, suicide ideation, drugs, grooming, radicalisation, and more.

✓ **Granular control over visibility:**Schools can customise when monitoring is active and adjust alerting intensity.
