From a Computer Lab to 1:1 Program: The Minarah College Digital Transformation Story

The challenge and its context

Minarah College traditionally relied on computer labs for learning which gave them lesser control and visibility into the devices used by students. This prompted the transition to a one-to-one student device learning program. They chose Microsoft Services as their standard operating environment to manage their digital ecosystem, which made rolling out a fleet of devices to all student cohorts at once challenging. But the main priority was to make sure all devices were safe and they had visibility and insights into student device usage to make informed safeguarding decisions.

Executive summary

Minarah College, an Independent Islamic school in Sydney's South West, fully embraced digital transformation by implementing a one-to-one student device learning program. Helping the pastoral teams help vulnerable students

Minarah College's pastoral team (consisting of heads of year) received regular reports on students' online activities, with Linewize Connect. These reports set up by the IT team highlights concerning patterns, equipping the team with crucial information to offer targeted support, especially to vulnerable students.

Over time, the team became more experienced in using Linewize Connect, and addressing flagged issues directly has become a common practice. The platform's extensive monitoring capabilities have helped identify concerning online behaviour, enabling timely intervention and informing counselling sessions for example.

Before engaging in conversations with students, the team delves into their online interactions, seeking to understand the motivations behind their choices. As needed, they then refer the students to the school counsellor or implement appropriate programs, based on the discussions.

This approach has allowed the pastoral team to have more meaningful discussions with students, enabling them to address students' concerns sooner and especially identify vulnerable students that often fly under the radar.
