How is a Day Designed?

Creating a Cyber Safety Day is like choosing your own adventure — there are many paths to take, and each one leads to a valuable experience for students, staff, and parents. You can start with foundational sessions to tackle core concepts, then dive deeper into specific topics through interactive workshops. Or, focus the day entirely on one of our enrichment activities for smaller groups. The choice is yours.

Where Would You Start?

Perhaps your school is dealing with a specific cyber safety issue affecting students, or maybe there's a year group struggling with an online trend. Here's How You Can Begin:

Select a Key Cyber Safety Issue

Start with a specific area of concern at your school—whether it's social media, online bullying, risky apps, deepfakes, or privacy. We'll design an experience around this focus, creating a day of interactive learning and expert guidance.

OR

Support a Year Group Grappling with Challenges

If one year group is facing particular issues, such as navigating social media safely or understanding digital footprints, we can tailor the day to address their needs through targeted workshops, deep dives, and open discussions with those specific groups, their parents and their teachers.

OR

Empower Your Parent Community

Start with an in-depth session for parents on digital safety tools and strategies, then offer follow-up workshops for students to maintain the conversation. This is a great option for schools looking to engage families from the outset—or for welcoming new families at the beginning of the year.

Choose Activities to Enrich Your Day

Once you've identified your starting point, it's time to build out the day with enrichment activities that bring the topics to life. Here's a look at some popular options:

Q&A Sessions

Create a safe space for students to ask their most pressing questions and receive real answers from an expert.

Roundtable Discussions

Bring together students, teachers, wellbeing staff or any audience for a collaborative dialogue on digital wellbeing and school policies.

Parent vs. Teen Evenings

Host a fun, interactive event where parents and students can learn together—ideal for breaking down barriers and sparking ongoing conversations.

Deep Dive Workshops

Hands-on workshops allow students to dig deeper into topics such as app privacy settings, recognising fake news, or building a positive online presence.

Case Study Reviews

For schools tackling specific challenges, these sessions use real-life scenarios to engage students and discuss practical solutions.

App and Social Media Safety

Equip students with the skills to navigate popular apps safely, understand privacy settings, and evaluate risks.

6 Examples of how you can Structure a Cyber Safety Day

Here are examples of how different schools have utilised our Build Your Own Day format to meet their unique needs:

Middle School Foundation & Deep Dive

Day 1

- Foundation session for Year 7s and 8s to establish cyber safety basics.
- Q&A session with Year 7 student leaders.
- Interactive deep dive for the entire Year 8 cohort or a roundtable with other year coordinators.
- Two smaller case study workshops for groups to discuss specific concerns.

Whole-School Cyber Safety Event

Day 1

- Morning sessions for Years 4 and 5.
- Roundtable: A student-led discussion on digital habits and challenges.
- Evening Parent Session.

Day 2

- Year 6 and 7 student sessions, followed by a Year 8 workshop.
- Staff session on academic and pastoral approaches to cyber safety.

Year 9 Intensive Cyber Day

Day 1

- Targeted day for Year 9, addressing common digital challenges in this year group.
- Foundation session, interactive workshop on sensitive topics like sharing nude images, and small group case studies.
- Evening parent education session to engage parents on supporting digital safety at home.

Two-Day High School Immersive Experience

Day 1

- Morning sessions for Years 7/8 and 9/10, focusing on foundational cyber safety.
- Roundtable with selected student leaders and wellbeing staff to discuss school-wide digital policies.
- Parent-child joint session to explore students' motivations online and encourage positive collaboration.

Day 2

- Deep dive on popular apps like Snapchat and TikTok, exploring security features and privacy.
- Interactive session for Years 11 and 12.
- Expert panel where students can ask anonymously submitted questions, opening an honest dialogue.

High School Deep Dive for Specific Year Groups

Day 1

- Focused sessions for Year 8 on Risky Online Behaviours and Digital Conduct.
- Year 10 sessions addressing echo chambers, online influence, and misinformation.
- Staff session and evening parent session to reinforce learning with a cohesive school approach.

Primary School Cyber Safety Day (Years 3-6)

Day 1

- Sessions for younger years to build early awareness of cyber safety.
- Year 5-6 sessions with more advanced topics on privacy and digital wellbeing.
- Meeting with the school executive and wellbeing team to assess current policies and align on best practices.
- Parent session to close the day with guidance on supporting online safety at home.

Each day is co-designed with a cyber safety expert to ensure it's aligned with your school's unique needs and goals, creating meaningful opportunities for connection and learning.
